

NOTICE TO GARNISHEES (Employers)

There are certain exemptions to garnishment provided by state or federal law. The applicable exemption to earnings is as follows:

Disposable Earnings. O.C.G.A §18-4-20 and 15 U.S.C.§ 1673. Garnishment of earnings from employment is limited to 25% of disposable earnings for a week or the amount by which disposable earnings for a week exceed 30 times the federal minimum wage.

Note: More money may be taken out of a paycheck for child support payments or if a Chapter 13 bankruptcy provides for a higher amount.

You should notify the Court in your answer if you believe an exemption applies to any such funds.
